# **PLAN OF ACTIVITIES**

A **social dinner by the Lake Iseo** will be hosted on Monday night. Seminars will be conducted through an innovative **learning-by-doing** style, which encourages group discussions and simulations of extradition and EAW proceedings. Seminars will also include the **sharing of experiences**, the viewing of **mini-videos** and the review of **famous extradition cases**.
